General Instructions to the SADHNA Award 2019 Applicants

1. Read all the instructions carefully. Incomplete applications will be rejected.
2. Only hard copy of the application will be entertained.
3. **Separate application should be sent for each award.** Write the name of the Award on the first page of the application. An applicant applying for more than one award can prepare a single draft/transfer the entry fee in total and the applications can be posted in one pack.
4. Write name on the backside of draft and photograph in lead pencil. Do not sign or put any mark on the photograph as it is to be scanned. Do not staple photograph and draft with the application rather put them in a separate envelope. Another photograph should be pasted on the cv/biodata page.
5. The fees may be paid in cash in the office of the Society OR remitted through bank draft drawn in favour of 'Society for Advancement of Human and Nature (SADHNA)' payable at any Nationalised bank at Solan or Nauni (Solan) OR through IPO favouring 'Society for Advancement of Human and Nature (SADHNA)' payable at Nauni (Solan) Post Office OR transferred online through NEFT/RTGS to the Society's saving account at UCO bank, Nauni (Account No: 09690110008362, IFSC code: UCBA 0000969). Send proof of transaction along with the application. **Do not send cash with the application through post.**
6. The number of awards and amount may vary. Decision of the evaluation committees will be final and binding in all the cases. All disputes are subject to the jurisdiction of Solan, HP, India.
7. All the awardees will be given plaques and certificates of honour along with cash awards, wherever applicable.
8. Convassing in any form will be a disqualification.

‘Above and Beyond’ Award

Three awards will be given to the scientists, teachers, extension workers, field workers, managers etc in the field of farming/agriculture and allied fields for their outstanding contribution. Their overall performance and contribution will be taken into account. Three cash awards of Rs 10,000 each along with plaques and certificates of honour. Awardees will also be included in the Permanent Honorary Board of the Society.

How to apply: Only Life Members/Life Authors of SADHNA can apply. Send resume/CV/bio-data (including full address, email and phone number) and a photograph along with recommendation letters from two persons of repute (including their full address, email and phone number). Additional information may be sought later.

Entry fee: An entry fee of Rs 200 will be charged with the application.

Paramount Achievement Award

Five awards will be given to the scientists, teachers, extension workers, field workers, managers etc in the field of farming/agriculture and allied fields for their exemplary work and contribution made by them. Five cash awards of Rs 5,000 each along with plaques and certificates of honour. Awardees will also be included in the Permanent Honorary Board of the Society.

How to apply: Only Life Members/Life Authors of SADHNA can apply. Send resume/CV/bio-data (including full address, email and phone number) and a photograph along with recommendation letters from two persons of repute (including their full address, email and phone numbers).

Entry fee: An entry fee of Rs 200 will be charged with the application.

Achiever Award

Ten awards will be given to recognize the contribution made by scientists, teachers, extension workers, field workers, managers etc in the field of farming/agriculture. Plaques and certificates of honour; awardees will also be included in the Permanent Honorary Board of the Society and get Life Membership of the Society.

How to apply: Send resume/CV/bio-data (including full address, email and phone numbers) and a good quality passport size photograph along with recommendation letters from two persons of repute (including their full address, email and phone numbers).

Fee: There is no entry fee for applying. However the winners of the awards will have to bear the processing and other incidental charges as notified by the Society from time to time after their selection for the award.

Braja Gopal Sharma Memorial All India Best Agricultural Extension Worker Award

Instituted by Ms Buntty Shylla in everlasting memory of her father Late Mr Braja Gopal Sharma, a great artist and social worker from Shillong, Meghalaya, the award is open for scientists who have excelled as extension workers in the area of agriculture and allied fields. The applicants should have contributed in the capacity of made remarkable contribution. Plaques, certificates of honour and cash awards (2 Outstanding Extension Workers of Rs 2500 each and 2 Best Extension Workers of Rs 1500 each).

Jagar Nath Raina Memorial All India Best Research Award at Doctorate Level

How to apply: An applicant should submit a summary of thesis, one page abstract, attested copy of the PhD degree and his/her one page resume including email, contact number and a photograph. Do mention the name, designation, address, phone number and email of your Guide/Chairman in your resume.

Entry fee: An entry fee of Rs 200 will be charged with the application.

Er JP Gupta Memorial All India Best Research Award at Master's Level

Instituted by Mrs Rajshree Gupta of Solan, HP in the memory of her husband, Late Er JP Gupta the award is open for the candidates who have obtained their MSc/MTech/MBA (not more than 10 years old) in agriculture or allied fields. Three Best Research cash awards of Rs 2,500 each will be given besides Plaques and certificates.

How to apply: An applicant should submit a summary of thesis, one page abstract, attested copy of the MSc/MTech/MBA degree and his/her one page resume including email, contact number and photograph. Do mention the name, designation, address, phone number and email of your Guide/Chairman in your resume.

Entree fee: An entry fee of Rs 200 will be charged with the application.

Uma Datt Mamgain Memorial Best Research Award

The award instituted in memory of Late Sh Uma Datt Mamgain of Shamti, Solan by his son Dr Sunil Mamgain is open for those who have obtained their Master's (including MBA) or Doctoral Degree from Dr YS Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry, Nauni, Solan or HP College of Agriculture and Research Complex, Solan (under PU, Chandigarh) or Agricultural Complex, Solan (under HPU, Shimla) or Horticultural Complex, Solan (under HPKV). Two Best Research cash awards of Rs 5,000 each for Doctoral and three of Rs 2,500 each for Master's research besides Plaques and Certificates.

How to apply: An applicant should submit a summary of his/her thesis along with his/her one page resume (including email, contact number and a photograph). Do mention the name, designation, address, phone number and email of your Guide/Chairman in your resume.
